# BASIC ELIGIBILITY



1. Be a U.S. citizen; permanent residents are not eligible.
2. Be in good academic and conduct standing at TAMU.
3. Have a minimum 2.25 overall GPR; 2.5 preferred.
4. Have valid health insurance during the internship.
5. Be enrolled as an undergraduate, master's, or Ph.D. student in the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences.
6. Be able to attend all pre-departure events in College Station, Texas.
