

BASIC ELIGIBILITY



- 1. Be a U.S. citizen; permanent residents are not eligible.
- 2. Be in good academic and conduct standing at TAMU.
- 3. Have a minimum 2.25 overall GPR; 2.5 preferred.
- 4. Have valid health insurance during the internship.
- 5. Be enrolled as an undergraduate, master's, or Ph.D. student in the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences.
- 6. Be able to attend all pre-departure events in College Station, Texas.
